The Guilderland Town Band will present the final concert of their 30th Anniversary Season, Thursday, August 12, at 7:30 PM at the Guilderland Performing Arts Center, in Tawasentha Park, Guilderland. The program will include works of Wagner, Debussy, John Williams, and two pieces by John Philip Sousa. To honor the 100th birthday of the great Duke Ellington, the band will perform a medley of eight Ellington standards arranged by Floyd Werle. The band will conclude its season with the exciting "Les Preludes" by Franz Liszt.

The eighty-five piece concert band will be under the direction of the band's founder, Don Webster. Guilderland Town Band performs each summer under the auspices of the Town of Guilderland Parks and Recreation Program. The concert is free and open to the public. The Guilderland Performing Arts Center is located in Carl Walters Tawasentha Park on Route 146 ¼ mile south of Route 20 in Guilderland. Parking is free and refreshments are available at the concession stand. The public is encouraged to bring a blanket or lawn chair. There is no rain date planned for this concert.
