Final Summer Concert

The free concert will be performed Thursday, August 7, at 7:30 PM in the Guilderland Performing Arts Center, in Tawasentha Park, Guilderland. The first part of the program will include an exciting opener "Fate of the Gods" by Steve Reineke, a beautiful rendition of the folk song "Loch Lomond" by Frank Ticheli, our feature vocalist RaeJean Teeter singing Gershwin's "Someone to Watch Over Me" and finishing up the first half with a John Philip Sousa March. Our second half will start off with an exciting march followed by "Jupiter" from Holst's The Planets and two medly pieces saluting Broadway and Jazz.

The band will be under the direction of Kathleen Richards Ehlinger. Guilderland Town Band performs three concerts each summer under the auspices of the Town of Guilderland Parks and Recreation Program. The concert is free and open to the public.
